## GARBAGE COLLECTION POLICY 2017 Beginning October 24, 2017

- GARBAGE CONTAINERS Each dwelling owner must provide enough garbage containers for their needs. The containers may be metal or plastic cans with covers, or a garbage bin with a lid. All garbage must be bagged before being put in the container(s). The bag together with contents must <u>not weigh more than 50 pounds or 22.5 kilograms</u>. The container(s) must be kept so that contents can not be scattered by animals or birds. Loose garbage will not be picked up. The owner shall be responsible for picking up and properly bagging loose garbage.
- 2. PICK-UP SCHEDULE Household garbage will be picked up as per schedule below. Garbage should be put out by 6 am. If your garbage is missed, it will not be picked up until the following week. The times may change due to starting of route change do not rely on the contractors to be at your home at a specific time. The pick-up day may change without notice due to statutory holidays and due to extreme weather. Household garbage does not include yard debris; therefore, yard debris should not be mixed with household garbage.

- 3. MARKERS/FLAGS Several residents have their own flags or marker that let the contractor know they have garbage, hanging the tied end of the bag slightly outside the edge of the container or garbage stand lid works great as well. For seasonal residents, this is especially great, as it increases efficiency for the daily routine and reduces the possibility of your garbage being missed. We ask all residents to take part in doing this for our contractors to ensure garbage pick-up.
- 4. **YARD DEBRIS** The pick-up of grass and leaves will be done periodically, as needed. Approximately every ten days. Debris must be in a compostable bag and placed next to your garbage stand, out of the elements when and where possible as moisture and sunlight cause the bags to easily rip. North Valley Waste Management requests the use of paper bags as they break down quicker in the pile.

Tree branches and hedge clippings will be picked up separately from leaves and grass clippings provided they are cut in approximately 3 foot lengths and bundled or they will not be picked up.

- 5. **RECYCLING** There is a blue box which is beside the Town of Fort Qu'Appelle's public works shop on Boundary Avenue for multi-use recycling. For more information please see the Fort Qu'Appelle website. No cardboard will be picked up, only household garbage.
- 6. **ILLEGAL DUMPING** Dumping of garbage, leaves, tree branches, grass or hedge clippings, etc. along a road allowance or on a public reserve is not permitted.
