



2020 General Election Candidate Information

Running as a candidate/candidate eligibility

You are eligible to run for council (including reeve) and for nomination if you are:

- at least 18 years old on election day
- a Canadian citizen
- a Saskatchewan resident for the past six consecutive months;
- not disqualified from being nominated by *The Local Government Elections Act, 2015* (LGEA) or any other *Act*; and
- are eligible to vote in the rural municipality.

Candidates require two voters to sign their nomination paper. If a candidate is running as a councillor, the nominators must be eligible to vote in the division the candidate wishes to represent. If the candidate is running for reeve, the nominators must be eligible voters of the RM. The candidate's nomination paper must be duly completed, signed, and accompanied by the candidate's signed acceptance. Effective January 1st, 2020, the Public Disclosure Statement is required to be submitted with nomination forms.

A person cannot be elected as a councillor in more than one division, or as a councillor of a division and as the reeve of an R.M. The 2020 General Election in the RM is for the offices of reeve, division 3 councillor and division 5 councillor.

Completed forms will be received at the RM office during regular office hours after the posting the Call for Nominations, and on Nomination Day between 9:00am -4:00pm. Nomination Day is Wednesday October 7, 2020. Forms can be submitted to an authorized election official by: personal service, registered mail, regular mail, fax or email.
